SkillsUSA Texas Postsecondary Leadership & Skills Championships will be hosted by St. Philip's College, San Antonio, Texas - March 4 - 6, 2010.

State Conference Registration:

- Registration will remain open from 01/04 – 02/12;
- There is only one way to register for the State Conference, online @ <http://skillsusa-register.org/Login.aspx>;
- Select “Conference”. Then select “My Registrations” or “New Registrants”. Then “Filter Event” to: *Texas SkillsUSA Postsecondary State Conference*;
- State Conference fees are as follows: \$50.00 for Students and \$30.00 for all others, including Advisors, Observers, Parents, Spouses, etc.

NOTE: If you have not completed your on-line registration to National SkillsUSA, <http://www.skillsusa.org/join/joinonline.shtml>, please do so prior to Monday, March 1st. If your students are not registered and paid SkillsUSA members they will **not** be allowed to compete in the State Championships. Membership fees are as follows: Students \$17.00 Professionals \$26.00.

You may also pay onsite on Thursday, March 4th. **Contestants will NOT be allowed to compete until all registration fees are paid.**
